

HEDIS FEEDBACK, 2019 - #3

TOPIC: Timing of Well-Child Visits

REMINDER: Coordinated Care pays for annual well-child exams! There is no need to check the date of last year’s visit, no need for 365+1 spacing, so it will be easier to schedule all patients, ages 0-21, for yearly physical examinations. Well-Child/Care Visits are paid based on the following HEDIS parameters:

- Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months of Life (6 or more visits); Well-Child Visits in the 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th years of life

For Foster Care: The state allows EPSDT Well-Child visits for foster care clients without regard to the periodicity schedule by billing procedure codes 99381-99385 and 99391-99395 with a TJ modifier.
